

Rules and Regulations/Appropriate Conduct:

Ontario Schools Code of Conduct: We wish to promote responsibility, respect, civility and academic excellence in a safe learning and teaching environment. Students and staff have the right to be safe and feel safe within their programs community. With this right comes the responsibility to be law-abiding citizens and to be accountable for actions that put at risk the safety of others and oneself.

- Attitude: Students will show respect to teachers, staff, and all other students. The Adult Education Staff reserves the right to deny entrance to the program to students deemed to be violent and disruptive to the moral tone of the program.
- Smoking: Smoking is prohibited in the school. Students may exit and re-enter the building at appointed break times.
- Academic Dishonesty: Academic dishonesty will not be tolerated. Anyone caught cheating on tests, assignments or projects will be given a failing grade for that work.
- Students must attend classes in a proper frame of mind. Any students obviously under the influence of alcohol/drugs will be asked to leave. Three such occurrences will be grounds for a six month retirement from the program.
- The Adult Education Program enforces a zero tolerance policy regarding any student uttering death threats against a fellow classmate, staff member or member of the community. The penalty for death threats is permanent expulsion from the program effective immediately. The incident will be reported to the Wikwemikong Board of Education and Wikwemikong Tribal Police.
