SCHEDULE TIME NOW TO ENSURE YOUR CHILD'S FUTURE

STRUCTURE your child's day and help develop self-discipline by creating and following a schedule that includes homework as part of their daily routine.

The Wikwemikong Board of Education has initiated a community wide homework strategy to raise awareness on the importance of completing homework on a daily basis. Homework is an extension of school work. Just as you would prepare a lunch and make sure that your child attends school on a daily basis, you should also ensure that they complete all homework assigned.

Encourage your child to study and finish their homework assignments by creating a quiet space in your home free of disruptions such as internet or television. Set aside at least two hours daily from 6-8 pm- Monday to Thursday for the completion of homework to help affirm your child's academic success. If no homework is given, offer an activity such as reading instead.

Schedule time now to help ensure your child's future by supporting their academic pursuits.
